

Gift Card Brief Case

Supplies

Corner Rounder
1/2" Circle Punch
1-1/4" circle Punch
Brad
Piercing Tool
Stamping Sponges
Soft Suede Ink
Tear Tape or other adhesive

Card Stock or DSP

6" x 4-1/4" (case)
2-1/2" x 4-1/4" (lid)
4" x 1/2" (handle)
2-1/8" x 4-1/4" (gift card holder)
Scrap of Soft Suede Card Stock

1. Score handle 1/2" and 1" from each end. Use 1-1/4" Circle Punch to round the ends. Score lid at 1" and 1-3/4". Round all four corners with a corner rounder. Score case at 2-1/4" and 3-1/2".
Sponge pieces with Soft Suede Ink.



2. Attach the back of the lid to the case back.
3. Fold case up and mark where closure should be. Punch a 1/2" Circle from card stock and attach it to base with a brad.
4. Punch a half circle in the 2-1/8" x 4-1/4" (gift card holder) piece. Put two strips of Tear Tape along the outside edges and attach it to the inside front of the case.
5. Lay the brief case out flat inside facing down. Fold up the handle and attach it to the lid.

Frugal Tip

If using 12" x 12" DSP you can get 3 Brief cases from one sheet by using the following cutting measurements

6" x 4" (case)
2-1/2" x 4" (lid)
4" x 1/2" (handle)
2-1/8" x 5" Card Stock (gift card holder) Score sides at 1/2" and turn under to form gift card pocket

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
