

Fry box Owl

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Supplies

1" Circle Punch

3/4" Circle Punch

Triangle Punch

2-3/8" Scallop Circle Punch

Fry Box Bigx L Die

Oval Framelits

Fancy Fan Embossing Folder

Lullaby Designer Series Paper

Wax Paper or Parchment Paper

Soft Suede Card Stock

Scraps of Whisper White, Basic Black,

Hello Honey Card Stock



1. Cut an oval from Soft Suede card stock using the 3rd largest oval framelit. Use the 4th largest oval framelit to round off the top of the owl's head.

2. Cut a Fry Box from Soft Suede Card stock and emboss the front portion with the Fancy Can Embossing Folder.

3. Punch out the pieces; Eyes: 1" Circle, Pupils: ¾" Circle, Beak: Triangle, Wings: 2-3/8" Scallop Circle (cut in half)



4. Assemble the fry box.

5. Glue the punched pieces in place then glue the oval to the back of the fry box as far down as it will go so the bottom of the oval will be hidden when the box is filled with treats.



Optional Fry Box Liner:

1. Cut a Fry Box from Wax Paper, Parchment Paper, Cello or another Food Safe product.

2. Trim the back so it's the same height as the front.

3. Press the liner into the box. I didn't glue mine. I left it loose so it can be removed. The treats hold the liner in place.
