

Album Tree Ornament

This little album in a box can hang in your tree as a decoration and then just slide the lid up the string to reveal the photo album inside. The box will accommodate extra pages depending on how thick your embellishments are.



Supplies

Matchbox die

Wide Oval punch

Scallop Oval Punch

Double Rectangle Punch

Crop-o-dile

20" of gold cord

20" of Whisper White Taffeta Ribbon

Baroque Motifs stamp set

Cardstock

Garden Green 2 - 1/8" x 11"

Garden Green (matchbox bottom)

Bride Specialty Paper 6" x 6.5"

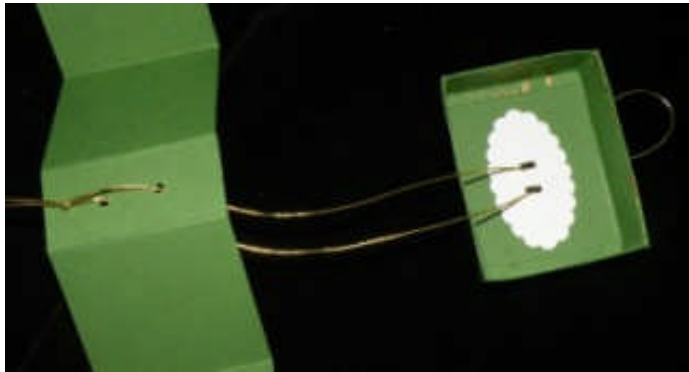
Scraps of Whisper White, Yoyo Yellow, Real Red, Tempting turquoise, Brilliant Blue

Instructions

1. Cut a lid using the bottom of the Stampin' Up matchbox die.
2. Cut a piece of cardstock 6" x 6.5" for the bottom of the box. Score all four sides at 2" and snip the score lines to the centre line.
3. Cut a hole in the lid with scissors or a craft knife. Punch two scallops as shown below

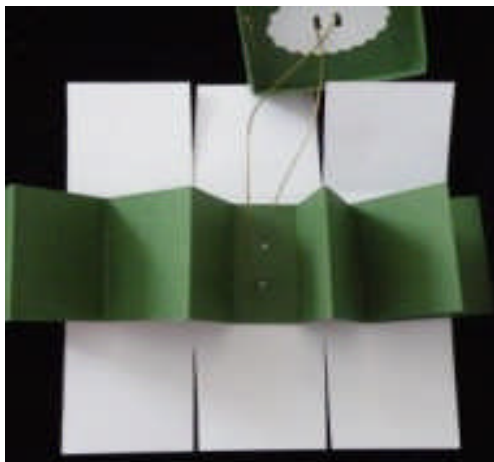


4. Cut 2 strips of cardstock 11" x 2 1/8". Score at 2", 4", 6", 8" and 10". Accordion fold, overlap the two pieces. And punch two holes with a crop-o-dile as shown below.



5. Sting ribbon or cord through the holes on the inserts and through the holes on the lid as shown. Tie in a knot in the bottom.

6. Stick the album piece to the bottom of the box as shown below and decorate as desired. To close your box, accordion fold the album pages, fold up the box sides and slide the lid down into place.



7. Embellish the top of your lid
