Faux Snow

Make some faux snow for your winter projects. All you need are some scraps of white cardstock and a cheese grater.

This gets a little dusty so if you're going to make a lot of faux snow you might want to take it outside. It took me about 5 minutes to grate enough snow for 40 swap cards.





1. Roll your scraps of cardstock into a loose roll and secure it with an elastic band while you work. Grate it with a cheese grater. I grated mine into an empty stamp container. You can also add dazzling diamonds if you want your snow to have some sparkle.





2. Apply glue then turn your piece upside down in the container and press it into the snow.



3. Let the glue set for a few minutes then dust the excess back into the container with a soft brush. Use this technique to make other colours as well.
