

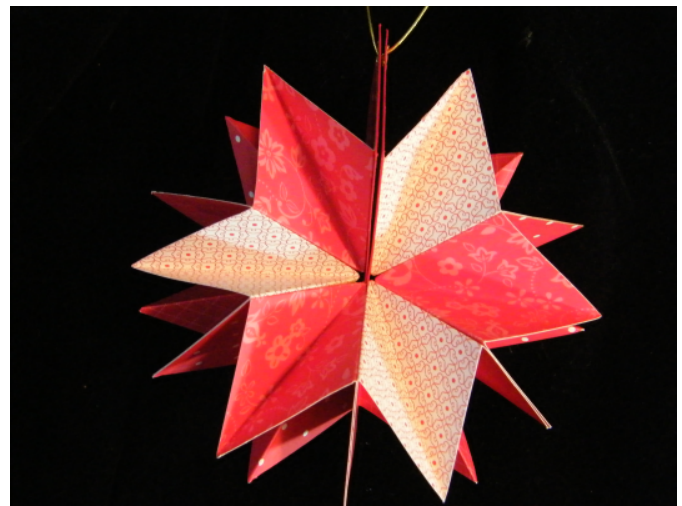
Star Card

This is a sample of the star card featured on Shelli's Blog.

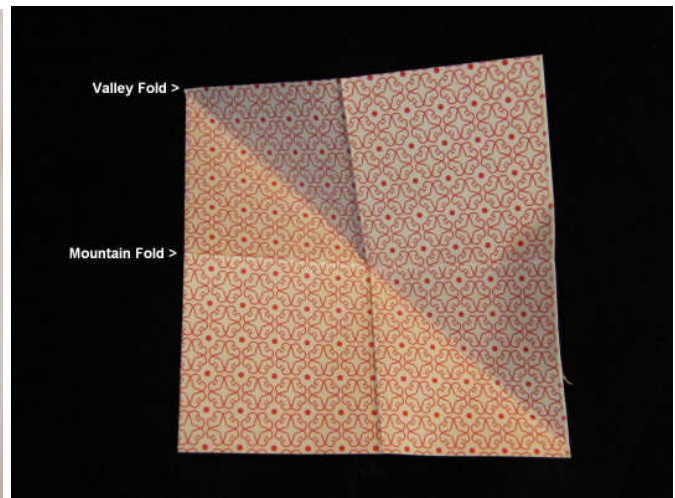
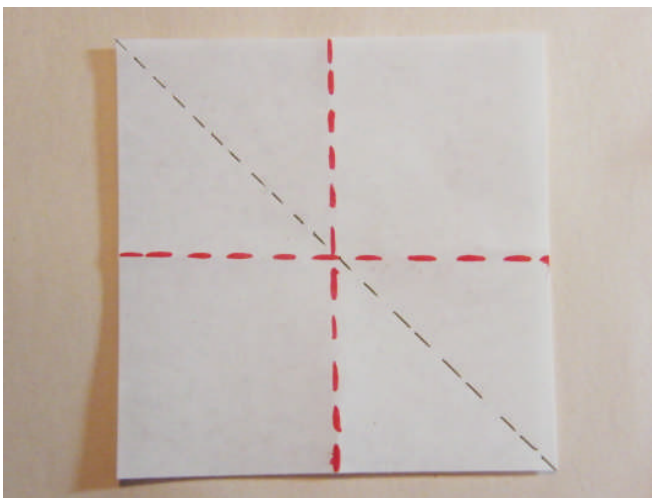
It was given to her by Felicity Gray from Australia.

This small card opens into an ornament.

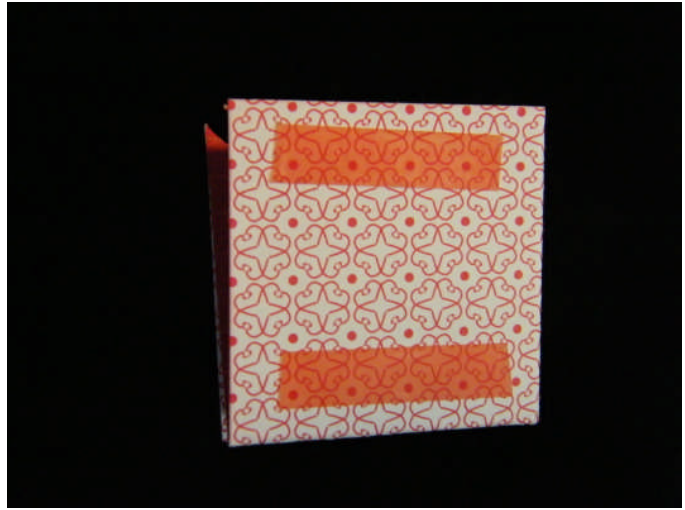

Felicity's star card uses five 4" squares of DSP and two 2 1/4" squares. I added a 6th square so I could alternate my DSP prints.



Fold your DSP into quarters (mountain folds shown in red)
Then diagonally (valley fold shown in brown)



Fold up your squares as shown above. Once all of your squares are folded then adhere one on top of the other. Make sure they're all pointing in the same direction.



Glue your cardstock squares to the top and bottom of the stack. Punch a hole in the cardstock and insert string or ribbon as shown in the photo.

Decorate your card.
