

Gnome Card

Supplies

- 4 ¼" x 11" Turquoise Card Base
- 4" x 5 ¼" Whisper White mat
- 4 ¼" torn strip of Old Olive
- 6 Daffodil large leaves
- 1 Old Olive large leaf
- 1 Old Olive large petal
- 1 Razzleberry large petal
- 1 Whisper White large petal
- 1 Blushing Bride large petal (or substitute)
- 1 Blushing Bride small petal (or substitute)
- 1 dark wide petal (or substitute) for shoes
- 1 Turquoise large leaf
- 2 Daffodil wide petals
- 1 Old Olive stem
- 2 eyes or draw them on with a marker

1. Glue the Whisper White mat to the card base. Glue the grass strip along the bottom of the card.
2. To make the flower, tuck the stem behind the grass and glue the flower petals in place. Trim the Razzleberry petal and glue it to the top of the flower. Glue the leaf to the stem.
3. Cut the dark wide petal in half for the shoes and glue them in place
4. Trim the points off the wide daffodil petals to use for elbows. Trim the pants as shown. Glue the pants to a large Daffodil leaf, tuck the elbows in behind and glue the body to the card.
5. Use the large leaf on the punch to trim the scallops off the Old Olive large petal for the hat. Trim the point off the White large petal for the beard.
6. Glue the hat and beard to the face. Add the nose and eyes.
