

Mason Jar Lit Frame

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Supplies

12" x 12" Painting Canvas

Battery Operated Fairy Lights

Acrylic Paint (for outer edge of frame)

Stampin' Up's In Good Taste Designer Series Paper

Stampin' Up's Birds and Branches Dies

Stampin' Up's Blossom Punch

Stampin' Up's Jar Punch

Stampin' Up's Mason Jar Shaker Domes (3)

Stampin' Up's Water Color Pencils (White)

Letter Dies or Stamps

Heart Punch or Die

Utility Knife and Cutting Mat

Glue Gun

Paper Snips

Bone Folder

Pencil

Tombow Multi Adhesive

Mini Dimensionals

Merry Merlot Ink and Sponge Dauber

Early Espresso Ink and Sponge

Crumb Cake Ink and Sponge

Stampin' Blends

- Old Olive Dark and Light
- Crumb Cake Dark
- Smokey Slate Dark

Card Stock

- 4.25" x 11" for backing (can be any colour)
- (3) 2.75" squares (can be any colour. I used Smokey Slate)
- White Card Stock for punching and die cutting
- Thick White Card Stock for letters
- Merry Merlot Card Stock for Punched Flowers

Instructions

1. Paint the edge of the canvas frame going a little higher on one side. *The higher side will be the bottom.*
2. Cut DSP 11" x 11" and sponge edges.
3. Punch 3 jars in DSP.
4. Glue the 4.25" x 11" piece of card stock to the back of the DSP and punch the jars in the same spots.
5. Sponge the jar areas so the white edges don't show.
6. Lay the DSP on the canvas and trace the jars in pencil.

7. Cut the area around the jars on 3 sides leaving the bottom intact.
8. Fold down the jar flaps, trim off the excess and glue in place.
9. Cut 4 branches from White Card Stock and colour with Stampin' Blends.
10. Punch 8 flowers. Colour the centers with a White Watercolor Pencil. Sponge around the edges with Merry Merlot.
11. Cut letters from Thick White Card Stock
12. Peel the front backing paper from each jar and stick them in place from the back.
13. Peel the backing paper from the back of the jars, add glue to the DSP and stick it in place.
14. Add the lights to the jars
15. Apply hot glue around each jar one at a time and glue the 2.75" squares over the lights.
16. Mark centre of frame, string ribbon through controller and glue ribbon to top of frame. Staple in place.
17. Add hot glue to the back of the controller and glue in place.
18. Add branches, flowers and letters.
19. Turn on the lights and enjoy your frame.
