

Simply Sent Cookie Box

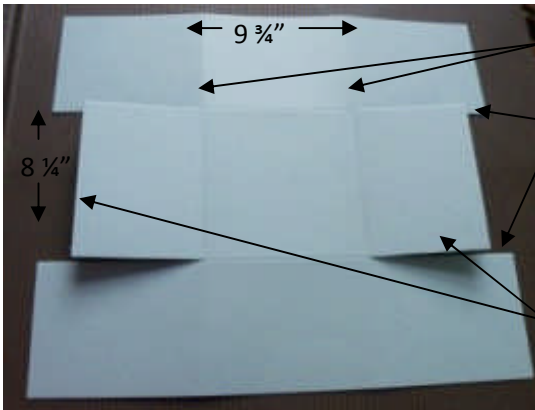

Supplies

Everyday Elegance Simply Sent Kit
Oval All Stamp Set
Basic Rhinestones
Calypso Coral Ruffled Ribbon
Simply Scored Scoring Tool
Large Oval Punch
Black Stazon Ink
Crop-o-dile
9-3/4" x 8-1/4" Baja Breeze Card Stock
Scrap of Whisper White Card Stock
Dimensionals
Glue dots (to adhere bow)

1. Cut a piece of coordinating card stock 9 3/4" x 8 1/4".



2. Score the 9 3/4" side at 3 1/4" and 6 1/2".

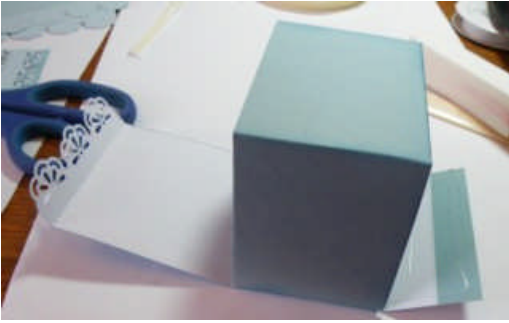
3. Score the 8 1/4" side at 2 1/2" and 5 3/4" then cut the sides up to the next score line.

4. Cut 3/4" off the two centre pieces.
Assemble and glue the box base.

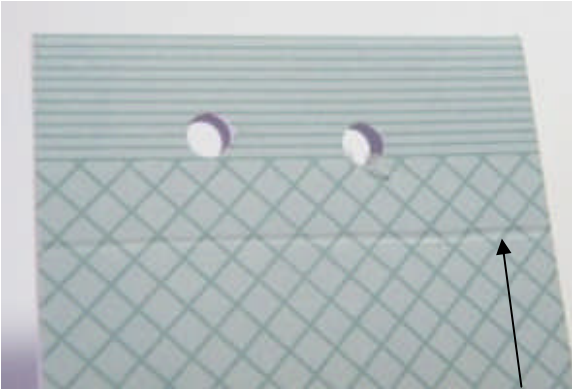


5. Cut one of the simply sent cards right after the third scallop (approx. 3 1/4"). Reserve the extra piece to make a tag.

6. Score at 1 3/4", 4 1/4" and just past the row of bumps (approx. 7-5/8")



7. Glue the top piece to the back and bottom of the box base.



8. Score the left over piece of card at 3/4" from the top fold. Punch 2 holes with a crop-o-dile and tie a bow through the holes. Decorate your tag as desired.



9. Stamp a sentiment onto one of the sticky labels that come with the simply sent kit. Stick it to the box front and embellish with rhinestones.

10. Tie a double bow for the top of the box and attach it with a couple of glue dots. *To make a double bow use 3 lengths of ribbon, fold two of the lengths into loops and tie them together with the third one.*



The finished box is approximately 3 1/4" wide x 3 1/4" long x 2 1/2" high. It's the perfect size to fit 4-5 cookies made with the Sweet Press Cookie Stamps.
